

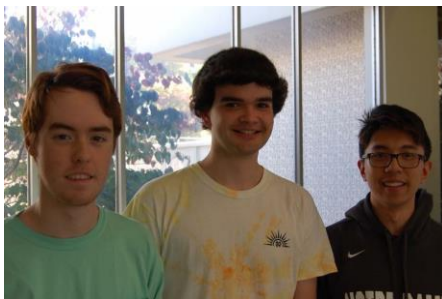
Notre Dame High School- November Highlights

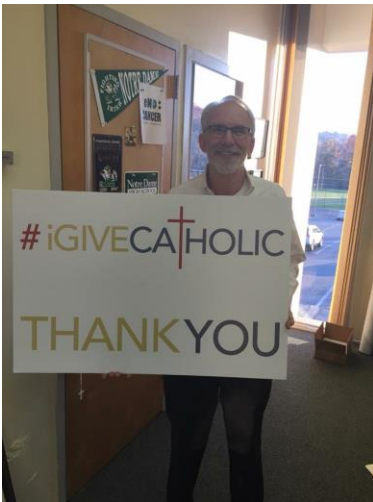
